

Personal data protection policy

When navigating this website, data of a personal character, necessary for the implementation of the registration service for the event offerered on this Website is collected.

Personal data so collected are processed pursuant to the "Loi relative à l'informatique aux fichiers et aux libertés" [French data protection act] of 6 January 1978 and the "Règlement général sur la protection des données" [General regulations on data protection] "RGPD" of 27 April 2016.

The personal data collected on the site is intended for Amundi Asset Management to register you for the event. Amundi Asset Management undertakes to delete your personal data within 2 months of the end of the event. The personal data required for your registration are : surname, first name, email, function and company.

The use of personal data is based on your consent, which may be withdrawn under the conditions indicated below.

The mandatory nature of personal data is indicated online when entering. The absence of communication of certain mandatory information may restrict or prevent certain functionalities of the site. Amundi Asset Management shall keep all personal information provided via the Website confidential and this in accordance with laws and regulations currently in effect.

The data is not sold, transferred, rented or given to a third party. Access to data is limited to persons authorized to process them by reason of their function.

The personal data thus collected may be communicated to subcontractors in the context of the operation of the Site or registration for the event.

Persons who have communicated their personal data via this site have a right of access, rectification and erasure of the data, the right to the portability of the data concerning them as well as a right of limitation and opposition to the data processing.

They have the right to withdraw the consent given at any time. Rights can be exercised
